

CITIZEN Warranty Certificate Identification

The hyphenated case number found on the back of the watch goes here. This number can be identified as 4 characters, a dash (-), then another 6 to 8 characters. This is required for warranty verification.

This is the model number of your timepiece. You can obtain this from the tag attached to your watch at the time of purchase.

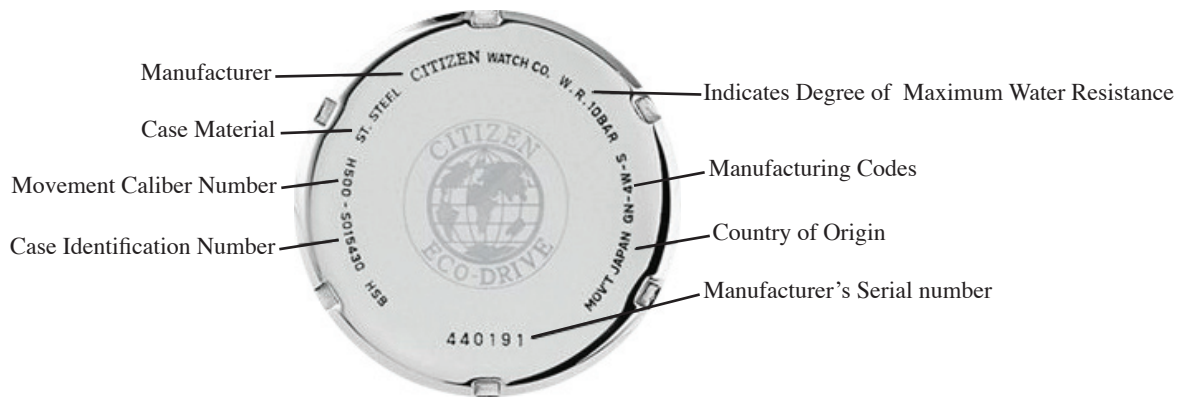
This is the serial number of the watch. It identifies this particular piece in a model series, Like the case number, this is required for warranty verification.
